Grants Awarded in the Third Quarter of 2016

**Brummitt Elementary –
Technology for My Tadpoles,
\$1,547.21**

Beginning with outside donations, Brummitt was awarded funds to be applied toward six iPad minis for a first grade classroom, allowing small groups to work together to partake in small group time, literacy centers, virtual field trips and more.

**Liberty Elementary – Scholastic
Leveled Book Room, \$2,000**

The Scholastic Leveled Book Room will provide teachers with access to multiple copies of books at their students' varied reading levels, which will be used in smaller groups with guided instruction, improving the students' confidence and reading abilities.

**Yost Elementary – Library
Materials, \$1,000**

After a \$500 donation was made by the Chelfs to the DEF to be provided to Yost Elementary for library materials, the school applied for and received a grant totaling \$1,000, which will be used to purchase encyclopedias and audiobooks.
